THE AMAZING MAIZE-FREE MAZE CHALLENGES ALL AT LUCKY LADD FARMS

EAGLEVILLE, TN. -- Lucky Ladd Farms has a corn maze with an unusual twist- no corn! The huge winding maze is planted with Sorghum – the first of its kind in Tennessee.

What is Sorghum? Sorghum is a type of drought resistant grass that resembles corn stalks and some varieties are harvested to produce a syrup similar to molasses. When planted densely-you cannot see through the rows which provides an extra *SWEET* challenge!

Jason Ladd, owner of Lucky Ladd Farms, says “The sorghum has done better than we ever imagined. I have been to a lot of other corn mazes and this maze just has a completely different feel. It has topped out at over nine feet tall in some areas and it is very easy to get turned around and stay lost once your inside, but that is also what makes it so much fun.”

This year’s theme for the maze is FARM FRESH FUN and it will keep you guessing at every twist and turn! Clues along the way will help guide you, but a wrong answer will lead you astray. The Amazing Maize-Free Maze is open for exploration both day and night. Grab your friends and flashlight and head to Lucky Ladd Farms for some good old country fun! All children under 13 must be accompanied by a parent or adult.

Admission to the maze includes a visit to Lucky Ladd’s petting farm, the largest in Tennessee, a hay ride featuring Tennessee wildlife and tons of fun at the huge playground areas. Other activities include rides around the farm on the barrel train, the new “Hare Racing Ag-venture” 100 foot monster slide and a concession stand. Lucky Ladd Farms fall maze and pumpkin patch is open Fridays 3pm to 9pm, Saturdays 10am to 9pm and Sundays 11am to 6pm starting September 26 through November 1.
